Because entries in the APA Dictionary of Psychology and Merriam-Webster's Dictionary are updated over time and are not archived, include a retrieval date in the reference.; The author and publisher are the same for the dictionaries in the examples, so the name appears in the author element only to avoid repetition.

Dictionary Entry References - APA Style
Don't include the place of publication or a publisher for an online encyclopedia or dictionary. Some electronic content is assigned a unique number called a Digital Object Identifier (DOI). If a DOI is provided for an encyclopedia or dictionary, include it after the name of the encyclopedia or dictionary of the entry and edition as "doi:doi ...

For the 6th Edition of the APA style Dictionary and Encyclopedia Entries A dictionary or encyclopedia entry is treated in much the same way as a chapter of an edited book, only you do not include page numbers. If the entry has an author, then attribute the entry as per normal.

7th edition updates. In the 7th edition of the APA manual, instead of starting with the title, the name of the dictionary's publisher is listed as author. You are also required to cite an online dictionary definition in the text of your paper. Your in-text citation for an online dictionary entry should include the dictionary name and the year the web page was updated. Your in-text citation might look like this: Coffee can be made either as a "decoction or an infusion" (Dictionary.com, 2015).
