YOU MUST ABIDE BY ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS. NOTE: Alaska, Arizona, Kansas, Maine, Mississippi, Missouri, New Hampshire, Vermont and West Virginia generally do not require a permit or license to carry a handgun openly or concealed by any person who may lawfully possess a firearm.

Concealed carry is only legal with a New York Pistol License (NYPL). The minimum age is 21, with the exception of honorably discharged members of the military, who can be any age. There are several types of NYPLs available, but the most commonly issued are the concealed carry and possess on premises licenses.

Concealed carry is legal with a Florida Concealed Weapons License (CWL) or a concealed carry permit from a state that Florida honors. The Florida CWL allows holders of the license to carry not only a handgun but also other weapons such as electronic weapons, tear gas guns, Billie clubs and knives.

Since New Hampshire has permitless carry, any person 18 years of age and older that can legally possess a firearm may carry a concealed firearm on their person without a license or permit. However, even though it is a permitless carry state they will still issue permits to residents and non-residents for reciprocity purposes .

Concealed carry is legal in Colorado for residents with a Colorado permit to carry a concealed weapon (CCW). This also

applies to non-residents of states with which Colorado has reciprocity agreements. CCW permits can be issued to any resident at least 21 years old and not prohibited by law from possessing a firearm.

Concealed Carry License On July 9, 2013, Public Act 98-63, the Firearm Concealed Carry Act became state law (430 ILCS 66). This law requires an Illinois Concealed Carry License to carry a concealed firearm in Illinois.

Concealed Carry License - Illinois

A License to Carry Firearms is issued to carry a firearm concealed on one's person or in a vehicle within this Commonwealth. Any person who carries a firearm concealed on or about his person except in his place of abode or fixed place of business without a valid and lawfully issued license commits a felony of the third degree.

According to Texas concealed carry laws, you might be able to have a drink while carrying a concealed weapon in Texas, but you certainly can't be "intoxicated." If you're at all impaired — and this includes drugs — or if you're above the legal alcohol limit, it is considered illegal to carry a firearm (even if you are licensed).
