What Are the Requirements of an Opinion Essay? Avoid Going Off-Topic: Always write within relevance to the assigned question. This is also known as "beating around the bush", and should not be included in any opinion paragraph as it may lower your grade. Indent the First Paragraph: With most academic papers, opinion writing is not different. It contains the rule of indenting the first line of the introduction.
