An open-access repository or open archive is a digital platform that holds research output and provides free, immediate and permanent access to research results for anyone to use, download and distribute. To facilitate open access such repositories must be interoperable according to the Open Archives Initiative Protocol for Metadata Harvesting. Subject repositories are open web collections of working papers or manuscript copies of published scholarly articles, specific to particular scientific disciplines. The first repositories emerged in the early 1990s, and in some fields of science they have become an important channel for the dissemination of research results. With quite strict inclusion criteria, 56 subject repositories were identified from a much larger number indexed in 2 repository indices.

An Open Access repository is a database or a virtual archive established to collect, disseminate and preserve scientific output like scientific articles and datasets and make them freely available. The action of depositing material in a repository is (self)archiving. Depending on personal preferences or publisher's policies, the author can make his work available in Open Access or (temporarily) restrict the access to it.

Many academic institutions that support open access archive their researchers' publications in online repositories that are freely accessible worldwide and easy to find online. The publication of academic information in these online databases is called the ' green road ' to open access; another term is self-archiving.

### Repositories

The Open Science Repository is a project to publish original research papers under open access, meaning readers do not need to pay to get access to full research content. Researchers from all fields of science can publish original papers and other scholarly communications through the sections of the Open Science Repository.
