Rate needs to be 100-120 compressions per minute. Use a bag valve or pocket mask to open the victim's airway with 2 breaths. Continue with 5 sets of 30 compressions, then give 2 breaths and keep rotating back and forth. Don't stop until an AED or emergency services arrives or until you're too exhausted to keep going.

When you have determined that the victim requires CPR, start CPR beginning with compressions. When the second person returns (without an AED in this case): You should continue chest compressions and count the compressions aloud each time you compress the victim's chest.

Deliver rescue breaths. With the person's head tilted back slightly and the chin lifted, pinch the nose shut and place your mouth over the person's mouth to make a complete seal. Blow into the person's mouth to make the chest rise. Deliver two rescue breaths, then continue compressions.

Prior to performing CPR. Prior to performing CPR, make sure the victim isn't in danger and that you won't be putting yourself in danger by rescuing them. An example of this is someone who is on or near high voltage lines. Either take steps to eliminate the risk or move the victim, whichever is safest.

CPR with an Advanced Airway An advanced airway is the use of a laryngeal mask, supraglottic or endotracheal tube. When you use an advanced airway, you do not stop compressions to give breaths like you do during 2 person CPR. Give one breath every 6-8 seconds and there should be no

pause in chest compressions for delivery of breaths.

For children compress  $\frac{1}{3}$  the depth of the child's chest or about 2 inches. For infants compress  $\frac{1}{3}$  the depth of the infant's chest or about 1.5 inches. An AED can help the heart return to a normal heart rhythm. Start CPR if a choking victim becomes unresponsive.

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
