The place Dupin and the narrator share is a "time-eaten and grotesque mansion" in an unfashionable and out-of-the-way part of the Faubourg St. Germain (an old-fashioned but still relatively aristocratic part of the Left Bank in Paris). And the fictional Rue Morgue is placed in a real section of Paris, the Quartier St. Roch (source).
